III. HOA OLD BUSINESS

- a. Common Area Rules/Signage

- b. Additional Landscape Updates
 - Retention pond debris was cleaned out by Total Solutions. It cost us \$1,200.

IV. HOA NEW BUSINESS

- a. Street signs should arrive by the 20th, Landon is starting this week
- **b.** Drainage pipe replacement at 235 Victoria Station should begin in a few weeks per update from HLL
- c. Enclave maintenance
 - i. The City of Alabaster did an inspection of the Enclave detention pond and drainage in June/July 2022. They found issues and contacted Drummond (the Enclave developer) at that time and after two months reinspected.
 - ii. As of two weeks ago, the city has reached to the HOA to make the necessary updates needed.
 - iii. There are 4 main issues:
 - 1. Drainage outlet is full of logs and boards
 - 2. Two lots (14 and 15) have erosion issues on the slope

- **3.** Too steep of slopes are eroded around two ditch outlets
- iv. We are emailing the city back with the following information as the current plan/solutions.
 - 1. Regarding the drainage outlet full of logs/boards we have hired HLL to clean the outlet, and it should be completed before the end of the month.
 - 2. Regarding the erosion on the slope of lots 14 and 15, we are speaking with Drummond to correct as this issue is on the lots themselves.
 - 3. Regarding the erosion around the two ditch outlets, we are gathering estimates and will move from there as to further action to take.
- **d.** Alabaster City Police requested us to allow them to install flock cameras at all 3 entrances.
 - i. Cost to the HOA would be \$229/camera/month totaling \$8,200/year.
 - ii. Unanimous vote of no
- e. Thanksgiving Canned Food Drive
 - i. Starts October 20th and runs through November 20th
 - ii. Josh motioned for the charity to be Manna Ministries as it is local in the city
 - 1. Scott seconded
 - 2. Approved by all
- f. Christmas Party
